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Experteze Research Team (ERT) is our primary forum for all Experteze Researchers to discuss and collaborate on multiple research topics of interest to them. Organized as multiple tracks, many ERT members attend these research meetings (held on Saturdays) and build professional camaraderie and relationships with other ERT members and guests. This is the forum where the members can propose new projects and obtain collaborative support, feedback on their ideas and obtain organizational and other resources to pursue their research interests.

ERT tracks include: (i) Artificial Intelligence tools in Bioinformatics, (ii) Bioinformatics studies of Parkinson's and Alzheimer's diseases, (iii) Bioinformatics studies of Cancer, (iv) Bioinformatics studies of medicinal plants, (v) Antibiotics, and (vi) All things Artificial Intelligence.

Some of our unique project efforts include the design and development of a student-led framework for collecting epidemiological data about neurodegenerative diseases as well as identification of novel molecules to develop new drugs for diabetes from medicinal plants with bioinformatics.
